

82ND ANNUAL MEETING

Our 82nd Annual Meeting was held on April 25, 2019, at the Downtown Greensboro Marriott. 81 members, staff, and board members were in attendance.

Our Board Chairman, Gregory L. Jenkins, II, gave his Chairman's Report on "How Change Challenges Us." He spoke of the impact of change through opening our Renaissance branch in 2018. He also reflected back on the storms our community has endured during this past year and how we came together with other local Credit Unions and organizations to get our community back on its feet.

Jerry Wise, President and CEO, recognized our volunteer board and thanked them for their service. He highlighted our 12% capital growth, the addition of two new Select Employee Groups, the anniversary of our Renaissance branch, and upgrades to our mobile app.

Shirley Massey from our Supervisory Committee provided information on our annual audit procedures. She confirmed the Supervisory Committee's satisfaction of Greensboro Municipal Federal Credit Union's accounting records and report accuracy, the sufficiency of internal controls, and that the plans, policies, and procedures established by the Board of Directors are currently being followed.

Our Nominating Committee Chair, Anne Gregory, announced the results of our 2018-2019 Board Elections. Pam McAdoo-Rogers, Rhonda Enoch, and Gregory L. Jenkins, II, were all re-elected to serve.

We also presented two scholarships worth \$1,000 each to Sidney Goetz and Miyah Donnell. Sidney is graduating from Grimsley High School and will be attending NC State in the fall. Miyah is graduating from the Middle College at Bennett and will be attending NC A&T in the fall. Congratulations Sidney & Miyah!
