


Wise Thoughts

If you realized that you gifted your future self \$20, what would you do? Save it or spend it?

\$20 might not seem like a lot, but small amounts make big impacts in the lives of our members every day.

With this in mind, we are lowering our base share deposit—the deposit that you made to become a member—from \$25 to \$5. On 1/1/2021, we released \$20 of your initial \$25 share deposit and that will now reflect in your available balance. This money has always been your money—we held it as your share of the credit union and now you will see your share of the credit union reflect as \$5. With this change, we are also reducing the minimum balance required to earn dividends from \$25 to \$5.

We believe that this change will make us competitive with other local credit unions while still providing current and potential members with all the great benefits of membership. It is our hope that by making our accounts more financially accessible we will be able to help more people in our community realize financial wellness.

So...what are you going to do with your \$20? If you haven't started an emergency savings account, we recommend that you consider using your \$20 to start one. It can be as easy as setting up a second share account and making regular deposits into that account. We can even do payroll deduction or an automatic draft into that account so that they can set it and forget it! Even as little as \$10 a month can add up over time.
